### About LINA Platform

LINA's main objectives are to work at the intersection of architecture and sustainability, to improve the working conditions of young architects and to enable them to collaborate with institutions that are generally more difficult to access.

Architecture is a creative practice that is constantly redefining itself and is currently facing the serious challenge of multiple crises: e.g. climate change, habitat loss, the housing crisis and the general decline in the quality of life on our planet. LINA, with a grant from the European Commission, carries out around 32 architectural projects a year and young professionals are financially supported to either further develop their own projects or are invited to collaborate with 34 partners.

Another objective of the LINA Platform is to mobilise the European architectural sector for clean, circular and sustainable architectural projects in connection with a new European Bauhaus. The LINA Platform aims to actively address climate and environmental challenges in the field of architecture and to find solutions for a more sustainable, equitable and economically sustainable future, linking and complementing each other in a European programme of architectural projects, research, workshops, roundtables, exhibitions, conferences and publishing projects. Our platform supports and co-creates projects that bring aesthetic, sustainable and inclusive elements of change to actively contribute towards making the European Green Deal a reality.

### What are our goals?

Two of the fundamental objectives of our platform are the annual Call for Projects, with which we support 25 projects by emerging architects and integrate them into the projects, work processes of the platform's members; the other objective is an international conference with speakers and panels, where solutions and projects for a more sustainable future are presented, as well as 25 outstanding projects by young architects. The rest of the submitted projects that are eligible and align with the LINA's objectives are more than welcome to collaborate with our network as well; thus we have successfully realised approximately 90 such collaborations in the LINA 1st year.
